
Overview

This standard covers the competences you need to obtain information on the destination and schedule of the explosive load by sea in accordance with approved procedures and practices.

You will be required to demonstrate that you can identify where information on the destination and schedule can be obtained, assessing any recent information that could affect the achievement of the destination and schedule in accordance with approved procedures.

This activity is likely to be undertaken by someone whose work role involves Weapons, Ordnance, Munitions or Explosives work activities. This includes people working as procurement and transport supervisors.

Performance criteria

- You must be able to:*
- P1 work safely at all times, complying with health and safety, environmental and other relevant regulations, legislation and guidelines
 - P2 identify where information on the destination and schedule can be obtained
 - P3 identify any problems with obtaining the information on the destination and schedule and take appropriate action
 - P4 identify any special requirements on reaching the destination
 - P5 identify any special requirements for timing the loading or discharge
 - P6 report any factors that could affect the achievement of the destination and schedule
 - P7 communicate in an appropriate manner with the relevant people

Knowledge and understanding

- You need to know and understand:*
- K1 the health, safety and environmental and other statutory legislation, regulations and safe working practices and procedures governing explosives and their implications for your area of work
 - K2 the relevance of personal protective equipment (PPE)
 - K3 the nature, characteristics, hazards and risks of the explosive substance and/or article
 - K4 the actions to be taken in response to an unplanned event
 - K5 the required information on the destination and schedule
 - K6 any special requirements
 - K7 typical of problems that could occur with the destination and schedule
