

Contribute to confirming the presence of munition(s)

Overview

This standard covers the competences you need to contribute to confirming the presence of munition(s) in accordance with approved procedures and practices.

You will be required to demonstrate that you can pinpoint and mark the position of the potential munition(s) to such proximity as to enable confirmation, reporting or challenge inconsistencies or anomalies of information in accordance with approved procedures and practices.

This activity is likely to be undertaken by someone whose work role involves Weapons, Ordnance, Munitions or Explosives work activities. This includes people working as munitions clearance operators.

Contribute to confirming the presence of munition(s)

Performance criteria

- You must be able to:*
- P1 work safely at all times, complying with relevant health and safety, environmental and other regulations, legislation and guidelines
 - P2 manage hazards effectively
 - P3 contribute to the selection and correct use of appropriate resources and equipment
 - P4 gain safe access to the potential munition(s) by the optimum means
 - P5 define/mark the route
 - P6 pinpoint and mark the position of the potential munition(s) to such proximity as to enable confirmation
 - P7 report or challenge inconsistencies or anomalies of information
 - P8 take prompt, corrective action in the event of problems arising
 - P9 communicate progress to colleagues

Knowledge and understanding

You need to know and understand:

- K1 the health, safety and environmental and other statutory legislation, regulations and safe working practices and procedures and their implications for your area of work
- K2 the relevance of personal protective equipment (PPE)
- K3 the actions to be taken in response to an unplanned event
- K4 the possible range and effects of hazards
- K5 why a particular detection method and certain resources are appropriate to the occasion
- K6 the interaction between suites of equipment
- K7 the basis on which you might report or challenge the accuracy or consistency of information
- K8 the correct use, capabilities and limitations of equipment
- K9 the stated criteria for searching the area and their implications
- K10 operational requirements and organizational procedures
