

## Drive the vehicle in restricted spaces

---

### Overview

This standards comprises the following elements:

- 1 Select a space for manoeuvring the vehicle
- 2 Manoeuvre the vehicle in restricted spaces

This activity is likely to be undertaken by someone whose work role involves Weapons, Ordnance, Munitions or Explosives work activities. This includes people working as transport operators.

Drive the vehicle in restricted spaces

**Performance criteria**

*You must be able to:* 1 Select a space for manoeuvring the vehicle

P1 work safely at all times, complying with health and safety, environmental and other relevant regulations, legislation and guidelines

P2 identify a safe and suitable space for the vehicle and the manoeuvring activities to be undertaken

P3 Determine whether the vehicle can be manoeuvred safely within the available space

P4 Identify alternative spaces if necessary

2 Manoeuvre the vehicle in restricted spaces

P5 work safely at all times, complying with health and safety, environmental and other relevant regulations, legislation and guidelines

P6 ensure that the space is clear of obstructions

P7 signal the intention to manoeuvre in sufficient time for other road users to take appropriate action

P8 monitor the actions of other road users throughout the manoeuvre

P9 manoeuvre the vehicle at an appropriate speed for the vehicle and its load

P10 manoeuvre the vehicle to maintain the safety of yourself and other road users

P11 manoeuvre the vehicle to avoid damage to the vehicle and the surrounding environment

P12 complete the manoeuvre so that the vehicle is in a suitable position for the required activities

- 3 legal, safety and operating requirements: highway codes, transport regulations, load restrictions, alcohol limits and drug restrictions, drivers' hours
- 4 road users: motor vehicles, motor bikes, bicycles, pedestrians, animals
