
Overview

This standard comprises the following elements.

- 1 Identify the legal, safety and operating requirements for the vehicle and the load.
- 2 Protect the vehicle and load from security risks.

This activity is likely to be undertaken by someone whose work role involves Weapons, Ordnance, Munitions or Explosives work activities. This includes people working as transport operators.

Performance criteria

You must be able to: 1 Identify the legal, safety and operating requirements for the vehicle and the load

P1 work safely at all times, complying with health and safety, environmental and other relevant regulations, legislation and guidelines

P2 obtain information on the legal, safety, and operating requirements that apply to driving the vehicle, carrying the load and the roads to be used

P3 observe the legal, safety, and operating requirements of the vehicle and the load, before and during driving

P4 ensure that you hold the correct driving licence for the vehicle being driven

P5 check that you are fit to drive safely in compliance with all relevant legal, safety, and operating requirements at all times

P6 identify any problems with complying with legal, safety, and operating requirements and take appropriate action

2 Protect the vehicle and load from security risks

P7 work safely at all times, complying with health and safety, environmental and other relevant regulations, legislation and guidelines

P8 apply the organisational security procedures to the vehicle and load, in different locations

P9 demonstrate the correct emergency procedures

P10 report any theft or damage, according to organisational procedures
